	TX-NSFR-2	Texas Department of Health must be notified on a form specified by TDH of any asbestos abatement activity, renovation, or operations and maintenance activity affecting ACM, or any demolition in industrial facilities or public buildings. 	TX-NSFR-3	Anyone engaged in asbestos-related activities in a public building in Texas requires licensing or registration from the Texas Department of Health, Toxic Substances Control Division, Asbestos Program Branch, Licensing Section. Licensing is required for the following positions: - Asbestos Operation and Maintenance Contractor; (25 TAC 295.43) - Asbestos Operation and Maintenance Supervisor; (25 TAC 295.44) - Asbestos Abatement Contractor; (25 TAC 295.45) - Asbestos Supervisor; (25 TAC 295.46) - Asbestos Consultant Agency; (25 TAC 295.48) - Asbestos Inspector; (25 TAC 295.50) - Asbestos Individual Consultant; (25 TAC 295.47) - Asbestos Management Planner Agency; (25 TAC 295.53) - Asbestos Individual Management Planner; (25 TAC 295.51) - Asbestos Project Manager; (25 TAC 295.49) - Asbestos Air Monitoring Technician; (25 TAC 295.52) - Asbestos Laboratories; (25 TAC 295.54) - Asbestos Training Provider; (25 TAC 295.55) and - Asbestos Transporter.
