2. Posting and Recordkeeping

Posting

The federal regulations for posting of injury logs at 29 CFR 1903 apply in Texas. There are no additional state requirements.

Recordkeeping

The federal regulations for recordkeeping at 29 CFR 1904 apply in Texas with a few additional requirements.

- Texas has additional rules for reporting injuries and conducting investigations, as well as provisions for reporting electronically or in paper format (25 TAC Part 1, Chapter 103).

3. Walking and Working Surfaces

The federal regulations for walking and working surfaces at 29 CFR 1910.21 through 1910.30 apply in Texas, with the following additional requirements:

- 16 TAC Part 1, Chapter 9 lists certain requirements (e.g., guardrails) for LPG installations.
- 16 TAC Part 1, Chapter 13 lists certain requirements (e.g., guardrails) for CNG installations.
