STP uses cookies on all our websites (the "Service"). By using the Service, you consent to the use of cookies.

Our Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how we use cookies, how third-parties we may partner with may use cookies on the Service, your choices regarding cookies and further information about cookies.

What are cookies

Cookies are small pieces of text sent by your web browser by a website you visit. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows the Service or a third-party to recognize you and make your next visit easier and the Service more useful to you.

Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies.

How STP uses cookies

"Cookies" are small text files that identify an individual computer's browser entering a web site. They allow the site to track that browser's movement through the site over several sessions. Through cookies, a web site can recognize repeat users, facilitate the user's access to and use of the site and allow a site to track usage behavior that will allow content improvements. STP uses cookies only for the above-mentioned purposes and to track non-STP's usage.

We use both session and persistent cookies on the Service and we use different types of cookies to run the Service:

- **Essential cookies:** enabling the navigation and functionality of the website, such as access to protected areas of the websites. We may use essential cookies to authenticate and identify users so we can provide you the services you requested
- **Functionality cookies:** analyzing your website usage and selections on the website to remember your preferences and personalize your website experience.
